Training activities sponsored with Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Funds, except for On-the-Job Training, Incumbent Worker Training, Tailor-made Training, Experiences Employment with or without pay and other exceptions described in the law and authorized by the Manati-Dorado Local Labor Development Board, will be offered under the modality of Individual Training Accounts (ITA'S).


The ITA'S will be available to participants from the municipalities that make up the Manati-Dorado Local Labor Development Area (*Barceloneta, Ciales, Dorado, Florida, Manati, Morovis, Vega Alta and Vega Baja*) for them to be effectively integrated into the labor market. This includes participants from the Adult Program and Dislocated Workers Program and Youth Program 18-24 years. Participants will select the educational entities in which they will be trained. These entities will be select the educational entities in which they will be trained. These entities will be those that belong to the State List of Eligible Providers of Training Service (ETPL).

This section 122 of the WIOA Act and the Regulations for the Determination of Initial and Continuous Eligibility for Training Service Providers, No. 8853, approved on November 18, 2016, as well as the approved Unified State Plan, the procedure to identify Training Service Providers. It is through competitive bases and the academic offers to be considered will be solely and exclusively those identified in the List of Occupations in Demand of the Local Area, as approved by the Local Board, and validated by the Labor Development Program (PDL).

Providers who are interested in integrating or maintaining their Training Programs in the *State List of Eligible Providers Training Service (ETPL)*, must request their inclusion through the ETPL module found in the *Participant Record Information System (PRIS)*.

According to communication by the Office of Planning, Evaluation, Validation and Statistics (PEVE) dated May 3, 2023, and circular letter WIOA-05-2023, the extension of the validity cycle of the State List of Eligible Training Service Providers for the AP 2023 is reported. So, the new deadline to submit proposals will be until Monday, June 5, 2023.
