SUBJECT: PUBLIC POLICY AMENDMENT YOUTH PROGRAM
ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: ADDITIONAL ASSISTANCE
REQUIRED BY A LOW-INCOME YOUTH TO COMPLETE AN
ACADEMIC PROGRAM OR TO MAINTAIN AND RETAIN
EMPLOYMENT

REFERENCE: WORKFORCE INNOVATION AND OPPORTUNITY ACT
(WIOA P. L. 113-128)

Based on a review conducted by the Monitoring and Compliance Division of the Department of Economic Development and Commerce (“DEDC”, or “DDEC” as per its Spanish acronym), it is recommended that the Manatí/Dorado Local Workforce Development Board make the following amendment as established in the applicable regulations. Therefore, the following amendment is hereby submitted in order to comply with the Public Policy and to ensure that it is in accordance with the Regulations, Manuals, Guidelines and Laws applicable for these purposes.

III. LEGAL BASIS

III. LEGAL BASIS

The legal framework is amended to read as follows:

- Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) PL 113-128 of July 22, 2014- Section 129 (a) (1) (B) (VIII), (C) (VII) and (a) (3) (B).
- WIOA Interpretive Regulations Subpart A-Sections 681.210, 681.220, 681.300, and 681.310.

APPROVAL AND EFFECTIVENESS

This amendment to the *Public Policy Youth Program Eligibility Criteria: Additional Assistance Required by a Low-Income Youth to Complete an Academic Program or to Maintain and Retain Employment*, shall be effective upon approval by the members of the Local Workforce Development Board and the Board of Directors of Mayors of the Manatí/Dorado Local Workforce Development Area.
